





# Moreno Valley Summer at City Hall APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The *Summer at City Hall* program is a partnership between the City of Moreno Valley and Val Verde Unified School District to provide incoming high school seniors at Rancho Verde High School with opportunities to develop job skills and foster an interest in leadership skills development and in civic matters. <u>Fifteen students will be selected to participate</u>. The program runs June 12 through July 6.

- Students will attend <u>class at Moreno Valley City Hall</u>, Monday –Thursday, 8 a.m. to noon.
- Students work in an internship in a City Department, Tuesdays and Thursdays, 1p.m. to 4p.m.
- Students will receive a \$300 stipend at program completion.
- Students will receive 15 community service hours.
- Lunch will be provided.
- Transportation to field trips will be provided.
- Orientation is scheduled for June 8.

## **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

Successful candidates must be an incoming high school senior and possess a **minimum GPA of 2.0**. He or she must possess good character with a desire to learn more about leadership and civic matters. The candidate must be ready to commit to a 4-week paid internship program within a City department during the summer recess.

#### APPLICATION PROCESS

- A. Applicant must submit a fully completed application and ALL requested information by mail, email, or walk-in.
- **B.** The following must be enclosed with the application:
  - 1. Two recommendation letters. (Teacher, Guidance Counselor, School Administrator, or faith-based leader)
  - 2. A one-page essay, typed, double-spaced, addressing the following:
    - o How this opportunity will help prepare you for the future
    - What you are looking forward to most about participating in this program
    - o How will your participation be a benefit to the community
- **C.** Copy of school issued identification card.
- **D.** Enrollment at Rancho Verde High School will be verified. Applications and additional requested information must be post marked, emailed, or walk-in by **Friday**, **April 14**, **2017** and addressed to:
